

BIBLE STUDIES STARTING IN LENT 2026

A STUDY OF THE GOSPEL OF MARK

The program will include an explanation of the origin of the gospel, an in-depth look at each passage, and will include group discussion and prayer. The study will be based on Dr. Mary Healy's Catholic Commentary on Sacred Scripture. Dr. Healy is a professor of scripture at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit and serves on the Pontifical Biblical Commission, which ensures correct interpretation of the bible, having been appointed by Pope Francis in 2014 and reappointed in 2021.



The study facilitator is Catherine Sanderson, a Lector at St. Catherine's and an experienced leader for bible studies, small group discussion, and prayer. The course will be offered virtually via Zoom for 10 weeks, starting on Monday, February 23rd, from 7:00 - 8:00 pm. All are welcome. Join us when you can as each session will be unique. LOVE IN ACTION



Society of
Saint Vincent de Paul

The **Offering on Ash Wednesday** will be for the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. It is one of two special collections that take place annually to support the work of the four Conferences within our Parish. Each of our Conferences need your support. Thank you for your continued generosity that has allowed our Conferences to carry out the following charity in 2025!

St. Catherine of Siena Conference: Total assistance provided in 2025 - \$46,636.

We estimate the total number of volunteer hours our Vincentians shared over the year to be 800 hours!

Regular Program: \$37,436 in assistance included Halifax Shopping Centre gift cards (can be used at Walmart and Sobeys, Mumford Road), assistance with electricity bills, and support for two people experiencing homelessness to find a home. This support was provided to 173 households (441 visits during the year), which included 306 adults and 292 children. 98 times, we shared groceries that are brought to Church each week by parishioners.

Christmas Program: \$9,200 in assistance provided to 62 families (127 adults and 83 children) in the form of Halifax Shopping Centre gift cards for food and a \$50 gift card for each child 16 years and under.

St. Patrick's Conference: Total assistance provided in 2025 - \$89,355.

Regular Program: \$67,730 in assistance provided which includes Sobeys gift cards, assistance with electricity bills, and other miscellaneous requests. That support assisted 600 adults and 560 children.

Christmas Program: \$21,625 in assistance provided (\$16,275 Sobeys gift cards and \$5,350 in gift cards to Halifax Shopping Centre - \$50 for each child). 145 home visits made which supported 219 adults and 107 children.

We have been able to complete this service to our community thanks to our generous supporters and Vincentians.


