The Holy See released a declaration on Wednesday in which the Cardinals preparing for the upcoming Conclave ask the faithful to pray for them.

"The College of Cardinals gathered in Rome, engaged in the General Congregations in preparation for the Conclave, wishes to invite the People of God to live this ecclesial moment as an event of grace and spiritual discernment listening to the will of God." The Cardinals said they feel "the need to be supported by the prayers of all the faithful", since they are aware of their responsibility in choosing the next Successor of Peter. 


Options for Giving to our Parish
